Congratulations on considering beginning your college education with a dual credit course through Spoon River College. Not only will taking a college-level course now benefit you in the short term, but taking dual credit courses while you are in high school will help you earn college credit at a price that your future self will thank you for!

Attached to this letter is an application for a dual credit scholarship through the SRC Foundation. Please note that, to qualify, you'll need to complete *every* field and, if you haven't already, apply for admission to SRC. **The application is due by the close of business on June 29, 2018**, and recipients will be chosen prior to August 1, pending the number of applicants and the availability of funds. We will notify you by mail either way as soon as possible once the recipients are selected.

Note that a dual credit scholarship may only be used for tuition and not books, fees, or other expenses incurred. In addition, the scholarship can only be awarded in the semester in which the SRC grade is awarded. If you are taking a spring semester course, or a year-long course, you are only eligible to apply for a scholarship for the spring semester for that course. If that applies to you and you're taking an additional course this fall, you may be eligible for a fall scholarship, as well.
