BEGINNING WOODWORKING Students in this class will learn about basic woodworking. Topics to be covered include; tools and equipment, planning and design, selecting materials, shop safety, material assembly and final surface preparation. Tools that will be used and demonstrated in class include; Radial Arm Saw, Table Saw, Jointer, Planer, Drill Press, Band Saw, Various Sanders, Router, Shaper and Portable Power Tools. Students will be given hands-on training and discuss woodworking planning and techniques, as well as, complete their own woodworking project utilizing the skills and techniques learned in class. (Ages 16 and older) Instructed by Stan Prentice. Fee: \$125.00 + Materials (Material fee is payable to instructor at class and can range from \$50-\$100 depending on project.)
