



## Caterpillar Student Trainee Online Application Process

Students may begin applying online Tuesday, January 1, 2019.  
**LAST DAY TO APPLY IS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2019 AT 11:59PM.**

To apply, students must follow the steps below:

- 1) Meet the minimum requirements
  - **2.8 out of 4.0** G.P.A. (cumulative, no rounding)
  - Legally authorized to work in the United States
  - Be a junior/senior in high school
  - Must be at least 16 years old by June 2, 2019
  
- 2) Create a resume / obtain a copy of your unofficial transcripts showing your current class schedule and cumulative GPA (you must attach your resume and transcripts to your application to be considered).
  
- 3) Apply on-line through [www.caterpillar.com/careers](http://www.caterpillar.com/careers)
  - Click on "Search For Jobs"
  - Enter job opening number (please see below) and click "Search for Jobs"
  - Click on Job Title
  - Click "Apply On-line"
  - Read and accept the "Privacy Agreement"
  - If this is your first time applying at [caterpillar.com/careers](http://caterpillar.com/careers), please click "New User". If you already have an account, please sign in.
  - If you created an account, click "Ok". If you just logged in, go to next step.
  - Complete each section of the application and click "Save and Continue" to move to the next section.
    - If you need to stop at any time, click "Save as Draft" before you exit.
    - Please upload your resume to your on-line application.
    - If a field does not apply to you and is not required (required fields are marked with a red \*), please leave it blank.
  - At the "Summary" page, please review your information and if you are ready to submit your application, click "Submit". If you need to leave and submit at another time, click "Save as Draft" before exiting.
  - Once you click "Submit", the next screen will state that the process is complete.
  - You will also receive an email stating that your submission was received.
